

## Crime Summary and Statistics

Below is a summary of information on campus crime statistics and security procedures at NMSU-A and is provided in compliance with the Jeanne Cleary Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Crime Statistics Act. NMSU-A's Safety and Security Bulletin can be obtained from the Office of Student Services or can be mailed to you upon request.

NMSU-A receives fire, security, and safety assistance from the Alamogordo Department of Public Safety (DPS) which is a multi-service emergency response unit. NMSU-A also receives assistance from the American Medical Response ambulance service.

If you are a victim of a crime while at NMSU-A, report it immediately to the Alamogordo Department of Public Safety and to the NMSU-A Administrative Office. To report a crime in progress or an emergency on campus on campus, dial 9 for an outside line and call 911 emergency response number. The Alamogordo Department of Public Safety will immediately respond to all 911 calls as well as any other reports of crime or safety concerns that are called to their non-emergency number at 439-4300. Prompt reporting of crimes or suspicious behavior greatly improves campus security and safety.

Students who are victims of crime may also pursue recourse through the NMSU-A Judicial System; call the Campus Student Services Officer (439-3716) for more information or for the specific process to be followed. Violations of the Students Code of Conduct can result in sanctions up to expulsion and criminal prosecution. Both the accuser and the accused are entitled to the same opportunities during hearings, and both shall be informed of the outcome of any campus disciplinary proceedings alleging sexual assault.

NMSU-A has two different security guards who alternate day, night, and weekend shifts. Their office can be reached at 439-3634. Security Guards patrol the campus to assist students and staff with safety concerns and to monitor building security. Upon request, campus security will escort students, faculty, and staff to their vehicles during the evening hours.

NMSU-A contracts with the City of Alamogordo for a uniformed DPS officer to assist with campus safety issues and law enforcement violations.

Free phones are available in the Library, Technical Education, Student Union, and Science Center.

A campus community relies on a peaceful, safe, and secure environment. Everyone shares the responsibility for making our campus safe. You are asked to be aware of NMSU-A's Policies and Procedures and to promptly report any crime suspicious activity. Be aware of your surroundings and avoid suspicious or dangerous situations.

NMSU-A strongly discourages any conduct that is illegal and that violates the rights of another individual. This specifically includes laws concerning possession, use, and sale of alcohol or illegal drugs. NMSU's policies on alcohol use, drug use, and crime are located in the Students Code of Conduct. The issue of sexual assault and other sexual misconduct is at the forefront of universities nationwide. NMSU has specific policies prohibiting sexual misconduct and will assist any victims seeking counseling (referral available through the Counseling Office), obtaining medical treatment, making academic changes, and in any way possible, including criminal prosecution through the District Attorney's Office, if the victim so desires assistance at any time.
