Associate of Applied Science Degree

Students who would like to design their own two-year program can do so under the auspices of the General Studies Associate Degree. This program requires the student to: complete a total of 66 credit hours (excludes non credit courses such as any “N” suffix course), complete ENGL 111G and COLL 101 with a *C* or better, achieve a

2.0 cumulative grade point average, and complete the last 15 hours from an NMSU campus (cannot be CLEP, ACT, challenge credit or credit from another college/university or correspondence school). A student who receives a designated associate’s degree is ineligible to receive a General Studies Associate Degree.
