

Registration Process for Senior Citizens for NMSU Alamogordo

Senior Citizens 65 years and older who are New Mexico residents can audit NMSU-A classes at the reduced tuition of \$5.00 per credit hour if they audit less than 6-credits on a non-degree status:

To register at the reduced rates, senior citizens should:

- 1) Complete admissions application in person or online at <http://nmsua.edu/admissions>. You will receive a letter in the mail confirming your admission to the campus or you can call 575-439-3600 after 24 hours to confirm and to obtain your Aggie ID number.
- 2) Complete a "Senior Tuition Waiver" form. See attached form.
- 3) Complete a registration card. Sign the front and back of the card. See attached form. You will be contacted the week classes begin to confirm your registration or call 439-3600 to confirm. *If a class is canceled you will also be contacted.*
- 4) Activate your online MyNMSU account using your Aggie ID number.
- 5) Pay a one-time admissions fee of \$20 (disregard if this is not your first class).
- 6) Pay your tuition after confirming that you are registered. You can pay over the phone at 575-439-3603, in person, or login and pay online at <http://uar.nmsu.edu/payment-options/ebillmake-a-payment/>.

Note: High school transcripts, college transcripts and orientation will be waived for senior citizens who are auditing less than 6 credits with a non-degree status. While auditing a course you will be able to fully participate in the class if you choose: you can complete all assignments, projects and exams. You will not receive a grade.

Tuition policies for seniors taking more than 6 credit hours:

New Mexico residents, 65 or older, who register on the first day of class after degree seeking students have registered for required courses, will be assessed the reduced tuition rate of \$5.00 per credit hour plus any university approved required fees. Senior citizen students will still be responsible for any applicable course fees including online and supply fees. *Per state law, senior citizens who take more than 6 credits must pay full price for all credits based on in-district or out-of-district residency.*

Senior citizen students may register prior to the first day of class, based on the designated registration time noted in the semester registration guide, but they will be assessed the full NMSU tuition plus university approved required fees and will be responsible for any applicable course fees (if registered for more than 6 credit hours).
