The Crimson Scholar program is a recognition and enrichment program for students of exceptional academic achievement. Designation as a Crimson Scholar is placement among the top New Mexico State University students. Crimson Scholar students must be continuing undergraduate students with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. Students must earn at least three (3) GPA hours per semester, and must be degree seeking.

**Crimson Pins:** Received after the accumulation of 24 Crimson Scholar credit hours.

**Commencement:** Accumulation of 38 Crimson Scholar credit hours AND a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above in the semester before graduation.

**Transcript Notation:** Accumulation of 45 Crimson Scholar credit hours and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above at the end of the last semester. "Crimson Scholar Graduate" will be printed on the final transcript.
