

Registration Instructions for Senior Citizens for NMSU Alamogordo

In accordance with Statute 5.7.19 NMAC, Reduced Tuition for Senior Citizens, students considered as Senior Citizens are eligible to enroll in classes at NMSU-A at the reduced tuition rate of \$5.00 per credit hour if the following conditions are met:

- **Student has been admitted to NMSU-A.**
- **Student is age 65 or older.**
- **Student requests the reduced tuition rate.**
- **Student is a New Mexico resident.**
- **Student is enrolled in 6 or less credits per term.**
- **Individuals wishing to receive this reduced rate tuition MAY NOT register for a course before the first day of classes. This registration can only be processed by the Admissions Office.**

Additional fees associated with enrollment may apply.

To register at the reduced rates at NMSU Alamogordo, senior citizens should:

- Complete admissions application in person or online at <http://nmsua.edu/admissions>. You will receive a letter in the mail confirming your admission to the campus or you can call 575-439-3600 after 24 hours to confirm and to obtain your Aggie ID number.
- Complete a "Senior Tuition Waiver" form.
- Complete a registration card. Sign the front and back of the card. You will be contacted the week classes begin to confirm your registration or call 439-3600 to confirm. *If a class is canceled you will also be contacted.*
- Activate your online MyNMSU account using your Aggie ID number.
- Pay a one-time admissions fee of \$20 (disregard if this is not your first class).
- Pay your tuition after confirming that you are registered. You can pay over the phone at 575-439-3603, in person, or login and pay online at <http://uar.nmsu.edu/payment-options/ebillmake-a-payment/>.

Note: High school transcripts, college transcripts and orientation will be waived for senior citizens who are auditing less than 6 credits with a non-degree status. While auditing a course students can fully participate in the class: all assignments, projects and exams can be completed. No grade will be received.
